

Agricultural Calander – February

Agricultural Operations	
1.	Ventilating greenhouses to avoid infection with fungal diseases, spraying copper carboxylate and fertilizing growth 17-10-27.
2.	Possibility of late-protected cultivation of cucumbers, tomatoes and melons, as well as open cultivation of eggplant, pepper, zucchini and corn in the Jordan Valley.
3.	Cultivation of potatoes in the Shafa Ghor and elevated areas, monitoring blight and spraying appropriate pesticides.
4.	Use specialized herbicides in wheat and barley fields.
5.	Maintaining and tying greenhouses in the Shafa regions to withstand strong winds, and continuing to clean rose plants from the infected and dry lower parts to prevent the spread of fungal diseases.
6.	If white flies and aphids are present on the vegetables, it is necessary to carry out a specialized insecticide by using Pyram, and in case mites are present, use Qwafenazate.
7.	Cultivation of fruit tree saplings in the permanent soil, with a diameter of not less than 1.5-2 cm.
8.	Continuing winter spraying after pruning the trees, and using Neemagreen + Deltaphon & a copper fungicide: Carboxylic Copper.
9.	When flowering begins and fruit sets for early varieties of almonds and apples, Super Fruit is sprayed and watering of fruit and olive trees is given when needed.
