

Agricultural Calander – April

Agricultural Operations	
1.	Ventilate plastic houses to reduce humidity and to avoid fungal diseases, and follow up on the work of leaching, pruning, spraying and picking.
2.	Possibility of harvesting American onions, garlic and potatoes.
3.	Cultivation of eggplant, peppers, tomatoes, zucchini, okra, cowpeas and faqous in Al Shifa.
4.	Cultivation of molokhia, okra and fodder corn in the Jordan Valley.
5.	Cultivation of summer fodder such as alfalfa, and preparing to start harvesting wheat and barley in the Jordan Valley.
6.	Shading greenhouses to reduce light intensity and high temperatures.
7.	Monitoring powdery mildew disease on fruit trees, vegetables and roses. If it appears, it must be sprayed with appropriate pesticides such as Last Point. The infection from tunnel makers increases on citrus. It is recommended to spray Neemagreen + Emafel.
8.	Continuing the possibility of grafting fruit trees by eye, and coating tree stems Nebranate to prevent insect and fungal infections.
9.	Water fruit trees once a week.
10.	Seedling annual ornamental plants and preparing them for marketing.
11.	Fertilizing crops according to the fertilization programs prepared for them.
