| Agricultural Operations | |

| 1. | Taking care of the exposed crops in terms of spraying with spider pesticides (Vertam, Toxamaite) due to their spread during this period, and monitoring the tunnel makers and the Tuta insect on tomatoes, melons and melons. |
| 2. | Start harvesting mallow and picking summer vegetables such as eggplant, okra and cowpea. |
| 3. | Continuing the process of irrigating and weeding summer fodder crops, harvesting alfalfa as needed, and adding nitrogen fertilizer after mowing. |
| 4. | Softening greenhouses when planting to reduce high temperatures. |
| 5. | Harvesting molokhia, eggplant and okra in the valley. |
| 6. | Observing the appearance of various insects such as tunnel makers, titmouses, spiders, grape moths, borers on almonds and apples, and when any of these pests appear, specialists should be consulted to combat them. |
| 7. | Thinning the fruits of almonds and apples to obtain the appropriate size of the fruits, as well as thinning the clusters of dates to reduce the phenomenon of Alternate Bearing. |
| 8. | Paying attention to irrigation and fertilizing crops according to the fertilization programs prepared for them. |
