

Agricultural Calander – July

Agricultural Operations	
1.	Controlling grape diseases and insects such as powdery mildew and grape fruit worm, using special pesticides such as Azodifel, Deltafon.
2.	Cleaning greenhouses from the remnants of the previous crop, plowing the land well, and sterilizing the soil.
3.	Removing unwanted growths and cankers on trees, and doing weed control in orchards.
4.	Controlling orchard irrigation at a rate of 1-2 times per week.
5.	Fertilizing crops according to the fertilization programs prepared for them.
6.	A mulching procedure around the stems of citrus trees to prevent water from reaching them, to reduce gumming, and adding iron to the trees to prevent yellowing of the new leaves.
7.	Follow the procedure of prevention and control of many diseases and insects, such as the olive fly insect, and fruit worms, and take into account diversification in the use of pesticides to avoid the emergence of resistant strains of pests.
8.	Mowing forage crops, and adding nitrogen fertilizer after mowing.
9.	Cultivation of potatoes in high and shallow areas.
